

Compton Care Half Marathon – Terms & Conditions

Date: Sunday 27 September 2026

Location: Aldersley Stadium

Start Time: 09:00

Cut-Off Time: 3 hours 30 minutes

1. General

1.1 By registering for the Compton Care Half Marathon (“the Event”), all participants agree to these Terms & Conditions.

1.2 The Event is organised by Compton Care (“the Organiser”).

1.3 The Organiser reserves the right to amend these Terms & Conditions where necessary to ensure the safe and successful delivery of the Event.

2. Entry & Eligibility

2.1 Participants must be aged 17 or over on the day of the Event (27 September 2026).

2.2 All participants confirm they are medically fit and able to take part.

2.3 The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry or withdraw any participant who appears unfit or behaves inappropriately.

3. Entries, Transfers & Refunds

3.1 All entries are **strictly non-refundable and non-transferable under any circumstances.**

3.2 Entries cannot be deferred to a future event.

3.3 If a participant is unable to attend, their place cannot be reassigned, credited, or exchanged.

4. Event Format & Cut-Off Time

4.1 The Event is a half marathon distance (21.1 km).

4.2 The Event will start at **09:00**. The start will be managed in waves to ensure a safe start.

4.3 The official **cut-off time is 3:30:00 hours from our last wave set off (approx. 9:30am).**

4.4 Participants who fall significantly behind pace may be asked to withdraw for safety reasons.

4.5 Participants who fail to meet the 3:30:00 hour cut off time can continue if they wish, however will not receive official race timing, signage may be taken removed, and marshals may not be in position.

5. Event Changes & Cancellation

5.1 The Organiser reserves the right to amend the route, timing, or format of the Event if required due to circumstances such as weather, safety concerns, or operational requirements.

5.2 In circumstances beyond the Organiser’s control (including but not limited to extreme weather, public safety issues, or other unforeseen events), the Event may be cancelled or postponed.

5.3 In such cases, **no refunds will be provided**, and the Organiser shall not be liable for any additional costs incurred by participants.

5.4 The registration fees cover the cost of the organisation of the event.

6. Health & Safety

6.1 Participants take part at their own risk.

6.2 Participants must follow all instructions given by event officials, marshals, and emergency services.

6.3 Suitable running attire and footwear must be worn.

6.4 The use of headphones is discouraged to ensure awareness of surroundings.

7. Race Numbers & Timing

7.1 Race numbers must be always worn clearly on the front of the participant.

7.2 Numbers and timing devices must not be swapped, transferred, or altered.

7.3 Any participant found using another person's entry will be disqualified.

8. Liability

8.1 The Organiser accepts no responsibility for any injury, loss, or damage to personal belongings, except where caused by negligence.

8.2 Participants are responsible for arranging their own personal insurance if desired.

9. Photography & Media

9.1 By entering the Event, participants give consent for photographs, video, and other media to be taken.

9.2 These may be used by Compton Care for promotional, marketing, and fundraising purposes without compensation.

10. Data Protection

10.1 Personal data provided will be used for the administration of the Event.

10.2 Data will be handled in accordance with UK data protection legislation.

10.3 Participants may receive event-related communications.

10.4 Personal data will be shared with RunThrough for administrative and safety purposes of the event.

11. Fundraising

11.1 Participants are encouraged to support Compton Care through fundraising, although this is not mandatory unless otherwise stated

11.2 The suggested minimum fundraising for this event is £250.

11.3 All fundraising must be conducted responsibly and lawfully.

12. Code of Conduct

12.1 Participants must treat others (including runners, volunteers, staff, and spectators) with respect.

12.2 Abusive, dangerous, or unsporting behaviour may result in disqualification and removal from the Event.

13. Acceptance

13.1 By completing registration, participants confirm that they have read, understood, and agreed to these Terms & Conditions.
